What are we learning?

At Weston Infant Academy...

Nursery are:

- Learning the phoneme 'd'
- Writing for a purpose e.g. children are writing their own cards for Valentine's Day and making friendship cards
- Matching patterns together and counting using 1:1 correspondence with heart shapes
- Making paper crafts with lovebird shapes

Reception are:

- Learning the phonemes 'ee' and 'ur' (as in fur)
- Reading the book the 'The Smeds and the Snoods' by Julia Donaldson and blending and segmenting words from the story
- Combining numbers to make 6, 7 and 8 and realising that numbers are made up of other numbers
- Adding spots to the lovebugs outdoors and printing patterns in the Maths area
- Colour mixing in the creative area and building a planet in the construction area

I1 are:

- · Learning the trigraph 'ear' that makes an 'air' sound e.g. 'bear'
- Reading 'The Lost Thing' by Shaun Tan and making a wanted poster
- Carrying out addition/subtraction with numbers up to 20 and finding different ways to make 20
- Completing vehicles with axles, axle holders and wheels in D & T
- Making sequences in P.E. and thinking about God in R.E.

12 and 13 are:

- Reading 'The Lost Thing' by Shaun Tan and creating a character profile about the lost thing
- Subtracting 1 digit numbers from 2 digit numbers
- Subtracting 2 digit numbers from 2 digit numbers using a Maths counting frame
- Thinking about what the passengers wore on the Titanic and about their cabins

What are we learning?

12 and 13 continued:

- Making healthy choices in Design and Technology
- Learning about spreadsheets in computing
- Looking at mirror dancing and repeating patterns in dance during P.E. sessions

At Weston Junior Academy...

Year 3 are:

- Writing about George making the medicine in 'George's Marvellous Medicine'
- Reading chapters 4 and 5 from the above text focusing on vocabulary and comprehension
- Dividing a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number e.g. 50 ÷ 5 = , 42 ÷ 3 =
- Looking at Van Gogh's 'Starry Night' painting using line technique/pastels
- Learning about fossils in Science
- Thinking about 'What does it mean to be a British citizen? in PSHE

Year 4 are:

- Creating a piece of writing based on 'The Inventing Room' chapter in 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory', focusing on dialogue - using inverted commas and apostrophes for contractions
- Focusing on equivalent fractions
- · Recreating an anti-bullying song, 'Stop!' in a rap style

What are we learning?

Year 5 are:

- Reading chapter 2 of 'Kensuke's Kingdom'
- Planning a balanced argument
- Thinking about subordinating conjunctions and the use of tense
- Looking at water resistance and stream-lining
- · Rehearsing a ballad in music
- Talking about the weather in Spanish

Year 6 are:

- Focusing on comprehension using Chapter 17 of, 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe'
- Learning about verbs and tenses (progressive, perfect, simple) and phrasal verbs
- Reading and interpreting line graphs
- Understanding the water cycle and the features of rivers
- Looking at Human Rights heroes in PSHE
- Looking at 'The Gunpowder Plot as part of 'The Stuarts History'
