What are we learning?

At Weston Infant Academy...

Nursery are:

- Recapping all of the phonemes that they have learned so far
- Looking at the characters from the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and labelling the characters using their phonics to help with the writing of graphemes
- Counting and matching the number of beans to a numeral
- Making a beanstalk and having fun in the garden centre role play area

Reception are:

- Recapping all of the phonemes that they have learned so far
- Writing speech bubbles for the characters in 'Jack and the Beanstalk'
- Matching digits and representations to 20
- Ordering the heights of the beanstalks
- Making castles from 2D shapes
- Planting beanstalks and playing a climbing the beanstalk game to find the harp and egg
- Threading harp strings and washing Mum's dishes

l1 are:

- · Learning the phonemes 'nk', 'air' and 'ur'
- Segmenting and blending real and nonsense words
- Continuing to retell the story of 'Fergus and the Sea Dog'
- Looking at multiplication and division
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Taking part in racing games/relays
- Completing and evaluating our windmill project in Design and Technology
- Observing growth and naming the different parts of plants

I2 and I3 are:

- Looking at 'w-ar' and 'w-or'
- Focusing on reading and comprehension skills how do we find the answers in the writing? Where do we look? How can we answer different types of questions?
- Learning about halving and doubling.
- Recapping the 2s, 5s and 10s times tables
- Taking part in games and races in P.E.
- Using algorithms and decision trees in Computing

What are we learning?

12 and 13 continued:

- Choosing and using different media for a suitable task in Art and Design
- Completing the research project to learn facts about King Charles III

At Weston Junior Academy...

Year 3 are:

- Creating pieces of writing based on 'The Enormous Crocodile', which includes direct speech and prepositions
- Finding a fraction of an amount
- Looking at the human skeleton in Science and learning the names of the bones
- Learning about the Romans Who invaded Britain? Did they succeed on their first attempt?

Year 4 are:

- Looking at a non-chronological report about a dragon linked to the text, 'How to Train your Dragon
- Learning about the use of adjectives and synonyms
- Looking at hundredths as decimals and making wholes with tenths
- Learning about the water cycle in Science
- Photo editing and combining photos in Computing

What are we learning?

Year 5 are:

- Planning a description of an island
- Focusing on descriptive detail and cohesion
- Continuing to learn the properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Introducing percussion and listening to music from 'The Fresh Prince of Bel Air'
- Using a range of batting techniques in P.E.

Year 6 are:

- Undertaking their SATs
- Learning about Kings and Queens as part of their learning about 'The Stewarts'
- Top Trump cards
