What are we learning?

At Weston Infant Academy...

Nursery are:

- Looking at syllables in words and recognising words that rhyme
- Copying using sound talk e.g. c-a-t
- Learning about Chinese New Year and making a Chinese symbol by writing and mark-making in glitter with chopsticks
- Accessing our Queen of Hearts counting table
- Pattern matching hearts
- Looking at symmetrical Chinese dragons
- · Painting love bugs using finger dot painting and making a Chinese lantern
- Building a body for the drago head in the contruction areas

Reception are:

- Learning 'ai' (Angry Red) in group 1 and 'ar' (Tricky Witch) in group 2
- Reading the story, 'The Smeds and the Smoos' and learning the nursery rhyme 'Daisy, Daisy'
- Making CVC words about the Smeds and the Smoos
- · Writing short captions and sentences
- Representing, understanding and subitising using numbers 6, 7, 8
- Recapping on doubles and looking at odds and evens
- Making a planet for Janet and Bill
- Colour mixing Smeds and Smoos
- Making Valentive hearts using a stained glass effect

Year 1 are

- · Looking at 'au' and 'air' and the prefix 'un'
- Retelling the story of 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'
- Ordering and comparing numbers within 20 and consolidation of numbers to 20
- Locating and naming seas around the UK
- Looking at the work of George Hayter (portrait artist to Queen Vistoria.

Year 2 are:

- Recapping 'dge'
- Using their imaginations to create a story about what happened on Sunday in the story of 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'
- Using their knowledge of the seas around the UK to describe where Grace Darling's rescue happened

What are we learning?

Year 2 continued:

- Looking at the work of George Hayter (portrait artist to Queen Victoria)
- Carrying out subtraction using 1 and 2 digit numbers

At Weston Junior Academy...

J1 are:

- Focusing on identifying coordinating conjunctions to write compound sentences in spelling, punctuation and grammar.
- Multiplying using column multiplication to multiply a two digit number by a one digit number in maths
- Identifying the 5 layers of the earth in Science
- Learning new songs in Songbirds sessions
- Learning about the Chinese New Year
- Carrying out activities thinking about mental health
- Learning about medicines in PSHE

J2 and J3 are:

- Using apostrophes for possession and similes to describe the nasty characteristics of the Golden Ticket winners
- Looking at correspondence problems in Maths
- Measuring in metres (m), centimetres (cm) and millimetres (mm)
- Focusing on healthy eating in PSHE
- Celebrating Chinese New Year by using keynotes to retell the story of 'The Great Race' - the myth which tells the story of the Chinese zodiac

What are we learning?

Year 5 are:

- Looking at Chapter 3 of Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief, focusing on comprehension
- Writing the up-levelled disciplinary report
- Thinking about e-safety in computing
- Learning about air-resistance in Science
- Learning about Chinese New Year
- Rehearsing for the recorder festival
- Thinking about how we stay healthy in PSHE

Year 6 are:

- Carrying out practice SATs papers and discussing their answers
- Considering which questions are best answered by Science or religion in R.E.
- Discussing apps and online communication in PSHE
- Visiting 'The Blue Planet Aquarium'
